

## June 19<sup>th</sup> Update

On June 12, 2020, the State of California and Nevada County moved into Stage 3 which allow our comfort stations and pool to open under strict guidelines. What this means for TTT, is the board and management have developed plans to open a limited number of comfort stations and explore opening the pool. At this time guests are still not allowed to enter the park per Nevada County Guidelines. A copy of the guidelines is published on our website under the title "Nevada County Guidelines, June 2020".

The following are updates on specific restrictions, plans and operations:

### Comfort Stations

We are looking to open 6 comfort stations on June 22, 2020 under the following conditions which meet the guidance provided by the Nevada County Health Department:

- Comfort Stations Big B, Big D, H, M, T, R/S will be opened for members use
- Comfort Stations will be deep cleaned twice per week and disinfected twice per day by TTT employees
- Comfort Station windows will be pinned open to promote airflow
- Comfort Station door locks and handles will be pinned open so the door can swing open when pushed on to enter or exit
- Paper towels will be available to use when you need to touch the door handle to open Comfort Station doors with the paper towel disposed of immediately into a nearby trash can
- Paper towel dispensers will be located on the inside or outside of the Comfort Station depending on which way the door swings when pulled open
- Comfort Stations will be open from 9am-10pm. They will be locked at 10pm to secure them at night from animals
- Members are strongly encouraged to bring and use their own sanitary and cleaning supplies to clean the bathroom fixtures after their use
- TTT will not be supplying supplies other than paper towels and toilet paper
- Members use of the comfort stations will be at their own risk

We are opening 6 comfort stations now as we currently do not have the staff to open more due to the level of cleaning and disinfecting required. We are looking to bring on several more work camper couples to bring us to full staffing levels, which may allow us to open more comfort stations. Members can greatly aid in moving towards opening more comfort stations by helping keep the 6 comfort stations clean after each use. We really need our members help to keep our park in compliance and not jeopardize the county closing our comfort stations for noncompliance. Also, with our members help, we can realize the goal of keeping

our members and employees safe and healthy while returning some normalcy to our park.

## Pool

The State of California and Nevada County has provided new guidance for opening our pool. The board and management are in the process of determining the training, staffing levels and associated schedule required to meet the Nevada County guidance. In addition, Nevada County will need to inspect our pool to confirm the higher chemical levels required and our plan meets their guidance. The timing for opening the pool to restricted operations is unknown at this time, due to the dependency on the county for inspection and the proper level of staffing required. We are working on recruiting more camp workers, however since all public campgrounds are opening, the demand for camp workers is very high and the supply is limited. Until we can recruit more camp workers we will continue to work on our plan and focus on the comfort stations.

## Open Board Meeting Saturday June 20, 2020 at 10am

The open board meeting will be held on June 20,2020 at 10am on the lawn at the rear of the Lodge. Some chairs will be made available and will be set up in small groups which will be spaced out appropriately to comply with social distancing guidelines. As the meeting will be held outside, those members choosing to attend may bring their own chairs and must adhere to social distancing guidelines of at least 6 feet between groups of household members. Also, as the meeting will be held outdoors, masks will not be mandatory and can be utilized based on the board members and membership discretion.

<u>Golf Cart Charging</u>	Normal operations
<u>Water</u>	Water system fully operational for members use
<u>Campfires</u>	Campfires are allowed per management evaluation of local weather conditions and Fire agencies recommendations or directives

Gate

The entry gate has been repaired and normal operations have resumed. Members first visit will still require manual operation of the gate with activation of members gate passes for future entry.

Site improvement and site sales inspections are ongoing and are handled on a first come first serve basis.
