

July 10th Update

We made it through the 4th of July weekend in a quiet and uneventful manner. The park missed all the normal activities and all its members enjoying the time with friends and family, but understood and respected the situation the park was under due to all the restrictions from the local, county, state and federal guidelines because of COVID-19. We appreciate the members who respected these guidelines as it protects its members, employees, and the park. I ask that those members who chose not to respect these guidelines, to think about the unintended consequences of your decisions. For this, I need to remind everyone, guests are still not allowed to enter the park per the State of California Stay-At-Home order and Nevada County Guidelines.

The following are updates on specific restrictions, plans and operations:

Dumpsters Please remember to latch down the lids on the dumpsters to deter animals from entering and tearing up the trash. We have had some recent activity and would like to address it now, so we do not have a bigger issue in the future.

Bears Bears have been sited several times wandering through the park lately....**Please do not give them a reason to stay!**

Remember to keep you sites clean, coolers stored out of site, food stored in airtight containers and trash removed from your site nightly and deposited in our latched park dumpsters.

Laundry Appointment only between 9am-5pm daily

Dumpsters 9am-10pm daily – locked at 10pm

Office Open for member business (Calls Only) and gate entry from 9am-5p and gate entry only 5pm-10pm daily

Propane Tanks filled daily at 9am

Honey Wagon Tuesdays and Thursdays – Please call office to schedule

Golf Cart Charging Normal operations

Water Water system fully operational for members use

<u>Campfires</u>	Campfires are allowed per management evaluation of local weather conditions and Fire agencies recommendations or directives
<u>Gate</u>	The entry gate has been repaired and normal operations have resumed. Members first visit will still require manual operation of the gate with activation of members gate passes for future entry.
<u>Site Inspections</u>	Site improvement and site sales inspections are ongoing and are handled on a first come first serve basis.
<u>Potential Buyers</u>	Potential buyers may enter the park per the rules outlined in the June 12, 2020 update and posted on the Membership for Sale webpage.
<u>Comfort Stations</u>	Currently 6 comfort stations are open. Future openings are dependent on available employees and demand.
<u>Contractors</u>	Licensed contractors and vendors with business licenses will be allowed in the park on a limited basis. (snow roofs, trailer moving/removal, RV repairs, etc..) Please contact the office to schedule access.
<u>Material Deliveries</u>	Material deliveries by vendors can resume but need to be approved by the manger and access scheduled with the office.
