



NOISE PRODUCING EQUIPMENT & ACTIVITIES

I. Generators: Bylaw 2.4 U9

- A. Generators must be attended at all times while they are running, and their use is limited to three (3) hours per day.
- B. Generators may be operated between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. only and are limited to 3 hours per day.
- C. Generators shall not exceed the National Park Service noise level of 60 decibels measured on the A-weighted scale at 50 feet (60 dBAs at 50 feet).

II. Chain Saws, Audio or Video and All Other Noise Producing Equipment:

- A. In accordance with Bylaw 2.4 U9, hours for use, duration and reasonable times are defined as follows:
 1. A chain saw may be operated between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. only.
 2. Use/operation of noise producing equipment which includes but is not limited to radios, boom boxes, stereos and any other audio or video equipment is permitted between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. only.

III. Loud Activities

- A. In accordance with Bylaw 2.4 U9 and as provided for under the rules of conduct, all gatherings, parties, and other assemblies must observe quiet hours between 10:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m.
 1. Such gatherings, parties or other assemblies may continue after 10:00 p.m., **if** there is no disturbing noise factor to any neighbor.
